This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into on ______29 April 2019 ___, by and between:

APPASAHEB BIRNALE COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, SANGLI, a college at South Shivajinagar, Sangli-Miraj Road, Sangli-416-416, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as, the "COLLEGE or First Party"),

AND

SHREE PHARMA, a pharmaceutical company located at Inam Dhamani, Sangli 416416, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as the "COMPANY or Second Party").

OBJECTIVES:

The objective of this MOU is to establish a framework for cooperation and collaboration between the COLLEGE and the COMPANY for promoting academic and research activities in the field of pharmaceuticals, including but not limited to:

- b) Continuing education and professional development programmes for faculties
- c) Joint conferences, seminars, and other educational activities

- e) Exchange of scientific and technical knowledge and expertise;
- f) Promotion of entrepreneurship and innovation in the pharmaceutical industry



MODE OF COOPERATION:

The mode of cooperation between the COLLEGE and COMPANY will be as follows,

- 1. Internship and training Program: The COMPANY shall provide opportunities for the students of the COLLEGE to undertake internships, in-plant training, and industrial visits at the COMPANY to gain practical knowledge and skills in the field of pharmaceuticals.
- 2. Continuing education and professional development programs: The COMPANY shall provide training and development opportunities to the faculty members and students of the COLLEGE on the latest trends and advancements in the COMPANY.
- 3. Joint conferences, seminars, and other educational activities: The COLLEGE and the COMPANY will jointly organize workshops, seminars, and conferences in the field of pharmaceuticals to exchange their knowledge, expertise, and research findings and to promote collaboration with the industry.
- 4. Research and development: The COLLEGE and the COMPANY will establish joint research projects in the field of pharmaceuticals, in which they will jointly conduct research and development activities. Both the parties will allow to use their research facilities and equipment's, as well as necessary personnel.
- 5. Exchange of scientific and technical knowledge and expertise: The COLLEGE and the COMPANY will exchange scientific and technical information, research findings, and expertise in the field of pharmaceuticals.
- 6. Promotion of entrepreneurship and innovation in the pharmaceutical industry:

 Through joint efforts, the parties aim to foster a culture of innovation and encourage the development of new ideas, products, and services in the industry. By working together, the COLLEGE and the COMPANY can leverage their expertise and resources to support and mentor entrepreneurs in the industry.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS:

The financial arrangements between the COLLEGE and the COMPANY will be as follows:

The COLLEGE and the COMPANY will share the costs of joint research projects and joint workshops, seminars, and conferences in accordance with the agreement reached between them. Each party will bear its own costs related to the exchange of faculty members, researchers, and students. The COLLEGE and the COMPANY will share the costs of joint publications in accordance with the agreement reached between them.

TERM:

This MOU shall remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from the date of signing, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement of both parties.

TERMINATION:

This MOU may be terminated by either party by giving a written notice of 30 days to the other party.

MODIFICATION:

This MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of the parties in writing.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS:

Any intellectual property generated through the joint research projects shall be jointly owned by the COLLEGE and the COMPANY and shall be subject to the mutual agreement and approval of both parties.

CONFIDENTIALITY

The COLLEGE and the COMPANY agree to keep confidential all information and data exchanged between them, whether it be scientific, technical, or business related, and to use such information and data only for the purposes of the joint research projects and other collaborative activities described in this MOU.

CERTIFICATION

Students who are successful in the assessment conducted by the COMPANY shall be awarded with a certificate post completion of the training, internship program.

GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION:

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MOU shall be settled by mutual agreement between the parties. In the event that the parties are unable to resolve any dispute, the matter shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with the Indian Arbitration and Conclusion Act.



SIGNATURES:

This MOU may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. This MOU shall become effective upon the execution of both parties.
